 The first thing to do in an emergency is to make sure everyone is safe.



- 2. Contact all relevant emergency services (Police, Fire, Ambulance). Dial 111.
- 3. Be guided by emergency services.

 Depending on the emergency, you may have time to switch off the electricity, gas and water; move electronics and valuables out of reach of flood waters; and check on your neighbours.
- 4. Follow your evacuation plan and ensure everyone is accounted for.
- Record the details of the emergency so you can report those details to appropriate authorities such as the Police and your insurance company.
- 6. Contact all relevant people on your emergency contact list about your situation.

- 8. Update your social media and website with a brief factual message about the situation.
- 9. Locate copies of your insurance policies, customer data, business continuity plan and other important business documents. These should be stored in a safe, offsite location.
- 10. Locate your data backups these should be stored in a safe, offsite location.
