This Easy Read is from Auckland Emergency Management.



Auckland Emergency Management is part of Auckland Council.



Auckland Emergency Management works to make sure everyone in Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland:



- knows what to do in an emergency
- is safe in an emergency
- can put things right after an emergency.



An **emergency** is when something dangerous happens that can put people at risk.




An emergency can be things like:



a flood



an earthquake





When an emergency happens everyone needs to act quickly so they can stay safe.





This Easy Read has information about:

- where to find information when there is an emergency
- who to contact when there is an emergency.

If there is danger



Use a phone to call 111 if you need:

- the police
- the fire service
- an ambulance.



Call 111 if:

- someone is badly hurt
- someone is very sick
- something is happening that is likely to hurt someone – for example a tree is about to fall down in a storm



 something like a fire is going to damage houses / buildings.



You can sign up to use the Emergency Texting Service **111 TXT** if you find it hard to:


- hear
- talk on the phone.



111 TXT is a service that lets you use text messages to tell the police about emergencies.

Auckland Emergency Management



Auckland Emergency Management can give you information about what to do in different emergencies.



Auckland Emergency Management also puts out **alerts** about emergencies in Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland.



Alerts tell you about:

 emergencies that are happening now



 things that could become emergencies at a later time like if very bad weather is forecast.

Get information on the radio




In an emergency you can listen to the radio to find out:

- what is happening
- what to do.



It is a good idea to have a radio that is powered by batteries to use when there is an emergency.



A battery radio will work if the electricity is off.



The radio stations listed on this page will have emergency information for Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland.



The number after the name of the radio station is the number to set your radio to so you can listen to that station.

This section is about what to do when there is a problem that:

needs to be fixed

but



• is not putting anyone in danger.

Use your phone to call **111** if there is serious danger.



Electricity

Contact your **electricity distribution company** if your electricity is not working.



Electricity distribution companies are in charge of power lines.



Vector Energy is the electricity distribution company for most of Auckland from:

• Wellsford in the north

to

Papakura / Manukau in the south.

Gas



Call the fire service on 111 if you:

- smell gas
- think there is a gas leak.



Here **gas** means gas that comes to your house in pipes for things like:

- cooking
- heating.

Water supply / wastewater

Water supply means the water that comes out of your taps.



Wastewater means everything that goes down your:

- sink
- toilet.



You can report problems with your water supply / wastewater to **Watercare**.



Watercare is the part of
Auckland Council in charge of
water supply / wastewater



(09) 355 3553




